Dear Parent

RE: Uniform and return to school in September.

I hope that you and your family had a relaxing summer break and that you enjoy the final few weeks of the school holidays.

As you begin to prepare for your child's return school this September I wish to remind all parents about the importance of adhering to the uniform policy (attached) and in particular footwear, hairstyles and piercings.

Footwear.

Black school shoes are the only acceptable footwear. Trainers should only be worn for PE. Canvas type footwear such as Vans, Converse, etc. are not acceptable.

Hairstyles.

Hair should be neat and tidy. Please ensure any extreme colours applied during the summer break as well extreme hair shaves and 'lines' have grown out or are removed prior to your child's return to school.

Piercings.

Students are permitted to wear ear piercings only. No other facial piercings are permitted and students should remove them when wearing their school uniform.

Sacred Heart College Uniform Policy

Our school uniform identifies the boys and girls as students of Sacred Heart College. While wearing it, students represent the school, its values and its traditions.

Proper attire and good grooming, as well as neatness and cleanliness, is expected of the students at all times. The school reserves the right to set the standards in relation to uniform and appearance. Students are encouraged to wear their uniform with dignity and pride and parental cooperation is always greatly appreciated.

School Uniform

- School uniform is compulsory, and students are expected to be always neat and tidy.
- Uniform consists of grey coloured trousers/skirt, white shirt, school tie and school blazer. School ties and blazers are available from local uniform stockists.
- A V-neck school jumper may also be worn (also available from local stockists). No other top may be worn.
- Students who wear a skirt must always wear tights during the school year.
- Skirts should be no shorter than knee length.
- Trousers should be regular school trousers
- Students who wear trousers must wear regular dark coloured socks

PE Uniform

- PE uniform consists of college shorts/leggings and college PE shirt (available from stockists)
- On days when students have scheduled recreational PE lessons they may wear PE uniform to and from school. On these days, students must wear plain navy or black leggings/training bottoms and a college top over their PE shirt. No other non-uniform clothing is permissible.
- Students may bring PE uniform to school in and change in the PE changing rooms before and after their PE lessons.

Footwear

- Black school shoes are compulsory for all students. Trainers and canvas type footwear are not permissible.
- Trainers may be worn as part of PE uniform kit only.

Overcoats

- Only a plain navy or black overcoat may be worn to and from school. Overcoats must not be worn during the school day except for break and lunch time. No other type of overcoat is permissible.

Jewellery

- One pair of stud earrings is permitted, all other facial piercings are not permissible and must be removed while students wear school uniform.

School Half Zips or Hoodies

- These may be worn **only** as part of PE uniform and on approved college outings.
